IST Survey

- ◆ International Standard for Testing Survey conducted by ANADO
 - 16 NADOs responded



IST Survey

- ◆ Registered Testing Pool Size
 - Answers ranged from 44 to 903
 - Average size approx. 400
 - Many NADOs have reported significant decreases in RTP size from 2008



IST Survey

- ✦ Formal Agreements with IFs
 - Most respondents did not have formal agreements
 - Those that had agreements were with 1 to 4 IFs
 - Many had informal agreements

IST Survey

- ✦ Testing within the 1 hour whereabouts period
 - Wide variety of responses
 - NADOs conduct from 15 to 90% of their OOCT during the 1 hour period



IST Survey

✦ Missed Tests in 2009 Q1

- Answers ranged from 0 to 18 Missed Tests declared in Q1
- Most NADOs did not declare a Missed Test



IST Survey

- ◆ Filing Failures in 2009 Q1
 - Answers ranged from 0 to 180 Filing Failures
 - Many NADOs did not declare a filing failure in Q1
 - On average 5% of athletes received Filing Failures

IST Survey

◆ Additional Comments

- Many NADOs are still in the process of completely implementing the 2009 IST
- Many would like to use ADAMS but cannot because of national privacy laws
